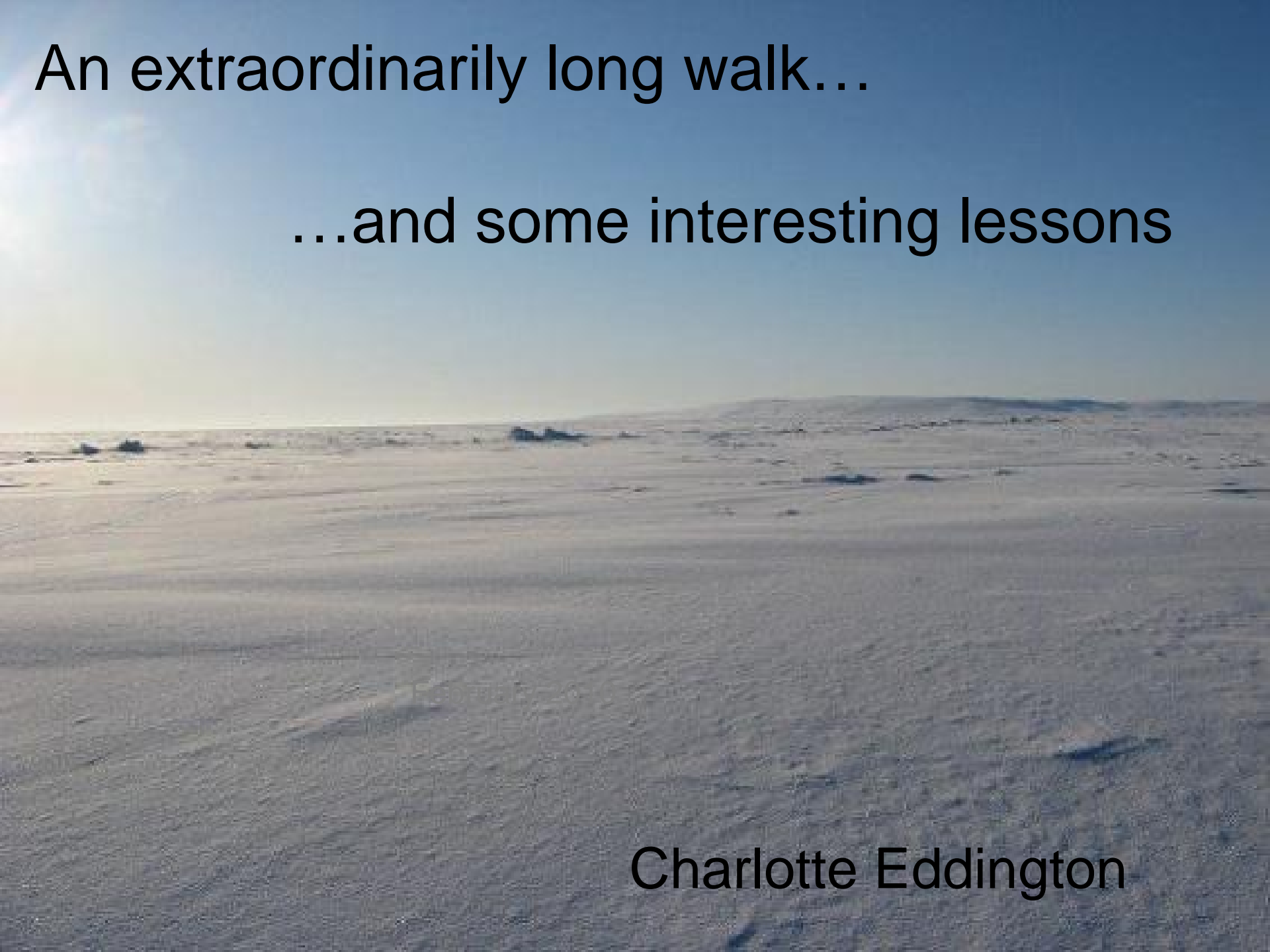


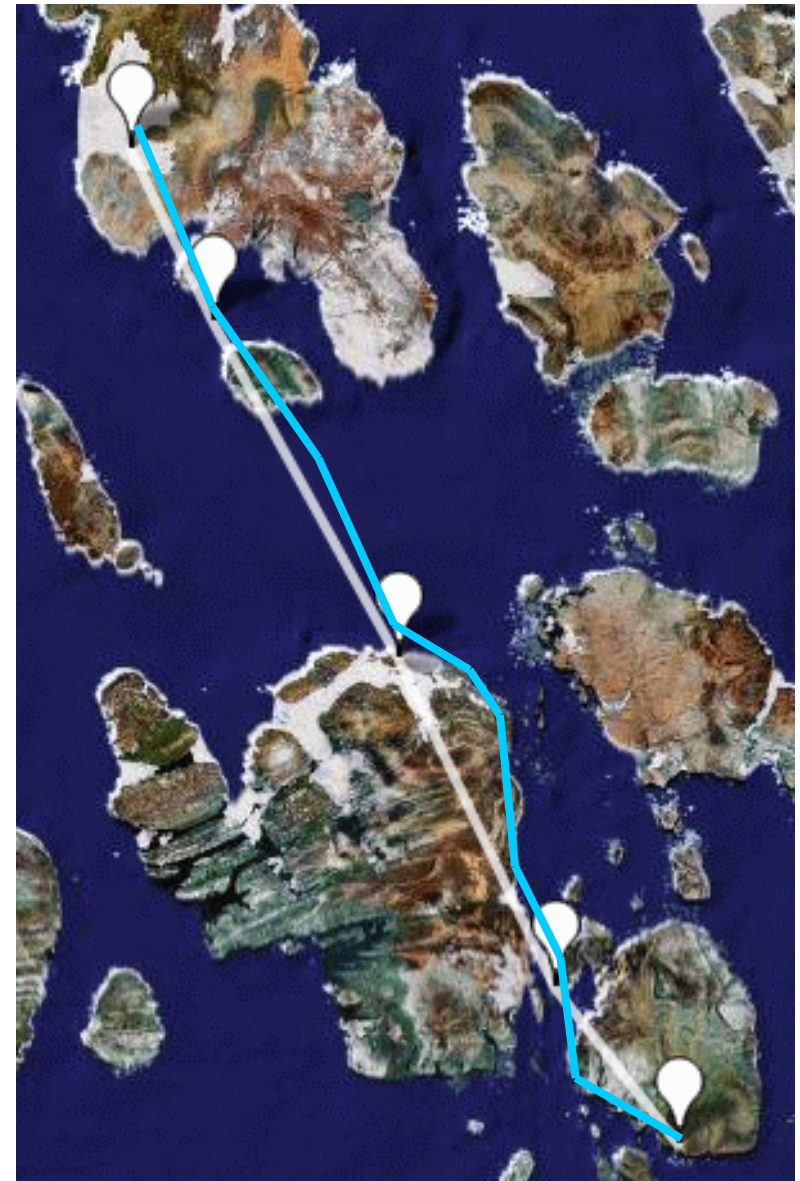
An extraordinarily long walk...

Distance Covered?	As the crow flies: 294 miles In reality: Approximately 350 miles
Days on the ice?	24 days
Average miles per day?	17 miles
Longest day?	18 hours, covering 32 miles (as the crow flies)
Lowest Temperature	-70 deg C (including wind chill)

Resolute Bay

- An Inuit town in the high Arctic (Cornwallis Island)
- Population of 229 people
- Second most northern permanently populated place in Canada
- Seasonal temperatures – average over the year of -16 deg C
- Population dependent on government support
- You can never rely on anything: weather, planes, people
